Trust representative Matthew Searle said: "If you're going away travelling, be prepared. The most important thing you can have is as much information beforehand as possible. On our website you can find out different information about different countries. There's cultures where you can get arrested for doing something you're perfectly allowed to do here. Being prepared is essential."
